

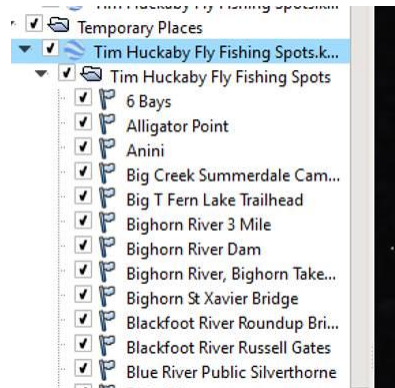
Unzip the KMZ file to your computer

Then install google earth pro (free) from here:

<https://www.google.com/earth/versions/#earth-pro>

then just double click on the kmz file and google earth will open it.

All the spots will be listed in the navigation called “Tim Huckaby Fly Fishing Spots” under “temporary places” (you can save that to my places permanently in google earth) like below:



Double click on any of the locations and google earth will take you right there.

In the browser it's a bit more involved. You have to create a blank map then import. But, bing maps, google maps and yahoo maps can all do it.
