

Unzip the file to your computer


Use the web version of Google Earth at <https://earth.google.com/web> and import the KML file directly.

or install google earth pro (free) from here:

<https://www.google.com/earth/versions/#earth-pro>

If you have mapping software installed on your computer you can just double click on the kml (or other mapping formats) file and it will be opened directly.

All the spots will be listed in the navigation called "Tim Huckaby Fly Fishing Spots" similar to below:



Double click on any of the locations and google earth will take you right there.

In the browser it's a bit more involved. You have to create a blank map then import. But, bing maps, google maps and yahoo maps can all do it.
